A. <u>Presentation: In-Home Support Services</u> (Melinda Tannan)

Melinda gave an overview of the IHSS program. The goal of the IHSS program is to allow people to live safely in their own home and avoid the need for out of home care. Services almost always need to be provided in your own home. If you receive supplemental security income (SSI) or meet all Medi-Cal income eligibility requirements, you may be able to receive IHSS. It is a Medi-Cal program and is funded by federal, state, and county dollars. Services include:

- 1. Personal care services (like dressing, bathing, feeding, toileting)
- 2. Paramedical services (like helping with injections, wound care)
- 3. House cleaning
- 4. Cooking
- 5. Shopping
- 6. Laundry
- 7. Accompanying someone to and from medical appointments

Melinda also provided information on how to apply for IHSS, how to hire a provider, how to keep track of the tasks performed by the IHSS provider and a list of things to avoid (like not sharing your financial information or lending money). Copies of a user-friendly IHSS guide were also provided.

B. <u>Training/Presentation Calendar for FY 2019-20</u>

Copies of the training/presentation calendar were provided. The discussion topic for next month's CAC meeting will be money management.
