Regional Center Community,

Due to concerns regarding increased COVID cases in Los Angeles County, we want our Regional Center community to be aware of the COVID testing resources available in LA City and LA County.

According to Los Angeles County, testing should be sought if an individual has symptoms of COVID19, was in “close contact” with someone who has COVID19 in the past two weeks, works in a place like a skilled nursing facility, residential care facility, correctional facility or homeless shelter, or someone who has frequent contact with the public, including working in healthcare, food or grocery services, retail, or public transportation.

LA County has upcoming **Pop-Up COVID-19 Testing Events**; these are walk-up events, which require appointments, and are no cost.

The site below requires an appointment:

December 9 – 13, December 16-17, and December 30 –McPherson Hall at Wilsona Elementary Campus, 41625 N. 170th Street East, **Lancaster**, CA 93535, 11 a.m. - 9:30 p.m. To make an appointment go to <https://lhi.care/covidtesting> and enter this site name or call (888) 634-1123.

The sites below do not require an appointment:

December 9 - 12 - St. Elizabeth Church, (on sidewalk), 14700 Kittridge St., **Van Nuys**, CA. 91405, 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.

December 9 - 12 - Bakman Ave. and Wyandotte St. (on sidewalk), 7255 Bakman Ave., **Sun Valley**, CA 91352, 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.

December 15 - 19 - El Nido Family Services (in parking lot), 11243 Glenoaks Blvd., **Pacoima**, CA 91331, 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.

December 15 - 19 - Home Depot (on sidewalk), 16800 Balboa Pl., **Van Nuys**, CA 91406, 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.

Please be sure to bring your insurance information. If you don't have insurance, bring your Driver's License or another form of identification. There is no cost for any test, whether or not you have insurance.
