Rate Change for Minimum Wage effective January 1, 2019.

STATUTORY PROCESS TO SEEK A MINIMUM WAGE RATE INCREASE FOR NEGOTIATED RATES

Effective January 1, 2019, due to the implementation of Senate Bill (SB) 3, the minimum wage in California will increase from \$11.00 to \$12.00 per hour for employers with 26 or more employees. As authorized by the 2016 State budget and the 2016 changes to the Welfare and Institutions Code (WIC) sections 4681.6(b), 4691.6(f) and (g), and 4691.9(b), many vendors will either receive, or be eligible to request, a rate increase if necessary to adjust employees' pay to comply with the new minimum wage.
