**To: In Home Respite Worker Rate Increase
Fiscal Management Services (“FMS”) under Service Codes 420 and 465**

**RE: Adjustment for Minimum Wage Increase effective January 1, 2019 pursuant to WIC,
Section 4691.6(g)**

Due to the enactment of Senate Bill 3 (“SB3”), effective January 1, 2019, the minimum wage in the State of California will increase from \$11.00 per hour to \$12.00 per hour for employers with 26 or more employees and from \$10.50 to \$11.00 per hour for employers with 25 or fewer employees. As authorized by the current State budget and Welfare & Institutions Code (“WIC”), Section 4691.6(g), effective January 1, 2019 the in-home respite worker rate will increase as follows:

Description	Current Rate	New Rate Effective January 1, 2019
1:1 Ratio, In-Home Respite	\$15.23 per hour	\$15.74 per hour
1:2 Ratio, In-Home Respite	\$8.19 per hour	\$9.84 per hour
1:3 Ratio, In-Home Respite	\$6.55 per hour	\$7.87 per hour
1:4 Ratio, In-Home Respite	\$5.73 per hour	\$6.89 per hour
