Economic Impact Payment Update **Some Eligible Individuals Must Take Action** **by Wednesday, April 22, 2020**

The IRS is working on sending out the Economic Impact Payment to qualifying individuals as quickly as possible. Some eligible individuals must register on the IRS's online web tool in order to receive the full amount of the Economic Impact Payment.

Individuals Who Must Register on the IRS's Online Web Tool:

Eligible individuals who aren't typically required to file a federal tax return and who have a qualifying child or children under age 17 must register with the IRS to receive the full amount of the Economic Impact Payment, including the additional \$500 per qualifying child payment.

Upcoming Deadlines:

- Eligible SSI benefit recipients who have a qualifying child or children under age 17 must register with the IRS to receive the additional \$500 per qualifying child payment. SSI recipients must register **by later this month, April 2020**. The IRS is expected to provide a specific deadline soon. Please check the IRS website for updates on the deadline. If you do not register by the deadline, you will only receive the individual payment amount (up to \$1,200) at this time.
- Eligible individuals who receive Social Security retirement, survivors or disability insurance benefits, (which are different from SSI benefits) who did not file a tax return for 2018 or 2019 and who have a qualifying child or children under age 17 must register with the IRS **by Wed., April 22, 2020** to receive the additional \$500 per qualifying child payment. If you do not register, you will only receive the individual payment amount (up to \$1,200) at this time. You will have to file a tax year 2020 tax return in order to receive the \$500 per qualifying child payment.

Eligible Individuals Who Are Not Required to Take Action:

The following individuals will automatically receive the Economic Impact Payment without taking action:

- Eligible individuals who filed a 2019 or 2018 federal tax return
- Eligible SSI benefit recipients whose benefits began prior to January 1, 2020 and who do not have a qualifying child or children under age 17
- Eligible individuals who receive Social Security retirement, survivors or disability benefits, or Railroad Retirement benefits, who do not have a qualifying child or children under age 17
