#### PROJECT OVERVIEW

North Los Angeles County Regional Center (NLACRC) is releasing this Request for Vendorization (RFV) to seek qualified and experienced In-Home Respite Agency to support school-age children, adolescents, and adults who have been found eligible for Regional Center services.

**Respite:** Respite, as defined by the Lanterman Act, Section 4690.2, describes this service as "intermittent or regularly scheduled temporary non-medical care and supervision provided in the client's own home, for a regional center client who resides with a family member". Respite is only provided in the consumer's home. This service is never provided in the respite worker's home and is not provided in the community.

#### INDIVIDUALS TO BE SERVED

This service will be provided to individuals with a developmental delay, those diagnosed with a developmental disability, and those at risk for a developmental disability with identified need of respite care per Individual Family Support Plan (IFSP) or Individual Program Plan (IPP) and assessment.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPLICANTS & DIRECT CARE STAFF

All service code 862 applicants must meet requirements per the following:

- D-2024-Rate Reform-013 Rate Reform Implementation for Respite Services Employer of Record and Participant Directed Services
- This is not an exhaustive list. All applicants must meet all relevant local, state and federal laws and regulations.
