PROJECT OVERVIEW

North Los Angeles County Regional Center (NLACRC) is releasing this Request for Vendorization (RFV) to seek qualified and experienced Personal Assistance providers to support school-age children, adolescents, and adults who have been found eligible for Regional Center services.

Personal Assistance offers a range of assistance to enable individuals to assist with/complete activities of daily living (ADLs), instrumental activities of daily living (IADLs). The service may include direct assistance (actually performing a task for the person) or supporting the individual to perform a task. Personal assistance services may be provided on an episodic or on a continuing basis when generic resources are not available. Personal Assistance may be used in the family home

INDIVIDUALS TO BE SERVED

This service will be provided to individuals with a developmental delay, those diagnosed with a developmental disability, and those at risk for a developmental disability with identified need of respite care per Individual Family Support Plan (IFSP) or Individual Program Plan (IPP) and assessment.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPLICANTS & DIRECT CARE STAFF
